3. What would you have done differently in this scene if you were the main character?
4. What advice would you have given to the main character to help them through their darkest moment?
5. What was the mood in the opening scene and how has the mood evolved throughout the book?
6. What do the descriptions of the setting throughout this read tell us about the characters? What role has the setting played?
7. What advice would you have given the antagonist right after their inciting incident?
8. How would this read evolve if told from a different character's perspective? Pick any character from this story and describe a pivotal scene from their point of view.
9. What impact has the narrator had on this story?
10. What character do you have the most empathy toward and why?
11. How has your perspective on _____ changed after this read?
12. What personal connections have you made with this read and how has it enhanced your personal journey?
